

SECTION VIII: SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION

Respiratory Protection:	Normally not needed in a well-ventilated area.
Ventilation:	Mechanical to maintain good airflow.
Protective Gloves:	Rubber.
Eye Protection:	Goggles or safety glasses.
Other:	As needed to minimize exposure.
Hygienic Practices:	Always wash face and hands after contact.
